New This Year... Any student who wants to access books in the Library must have a membership.

Membership Options

For Students in Grades 1-8. Memberships must be renewed each school year. Any students who would like to read our library books must be a library member ... regardless if they want to take books home or not.

Base Membership – \$5.00/year

Student may read during recess, and may borrow ONE book at a time for a period of one week.

Supporting Membership – \$10.00/year

Student may read during recess, and may borrow TWO books at a time for a period of one week.

Additional Fees

All Library members have fair and equal chance to access all our Library books. Members should please make every effort to return borrowed books on-time to the Library. If any books are lost or returned damaged, a fine to the discretion of the Librarian will be issued. All fees collected go towards maintaining the library and acquiring new books.*

- Late fees will be assessed at \$0.20 per day, including non-school days.
- Lost books will be assessed at Replacement Cost plus 15%.
- Damaged books will be assessed according to the Bookbinder's Repair Fees.

* In accordance with a commonly issued directive of the Rebbe, that fee-for-service enhances the value of the service to both the provider and recipient.
